



COVID-19 DAILY HEALTH QUESTIONNAIRE

GET STARTED:

- Click the link [here](#) to be taken to the ViacomCBS online health questionnaire.
- The date will be automatically selected as the pass is only good for the day you submit and you cannot load entries for future dates. The questionnaire must be submitted on the same day of scheduled work to obtain the most accurate health information.

SUBMITTING:

- Select the work location you will be accessing that day.
- Select the project you are working on.
- You will be able to submit using your name; you will need to type **YOUR COMPLETE** last name or first name (or both) for the database to begin searching for you.
- Once you find your name and select it, the questionnaire will pull the necessary data from your profile created by the site admin and HR teams.
- If your name does not appear then you have not been cleared to access any ViacomCBS work sites. Contact the building HR or Security teams to begin the access process.
